

BIO-SWEET 5

Product Description

BIO-SWEET is a stable combination of fructose and sucrose sugars manufactured from food grade sources. The product is 61% by weight dry sugar solids and formulated to be withstand temperatures of negative (-) 30 F. The product contains 4% by weight available K₂O (0-0-4).

Application Rates

For most applications, a rate of 8 oz. per 100 gallons of water is sufficient. Use the graph to determine precise application rates.

- Slightly more viscous than water
- Fructose – 25% minimum
